TERUMAH 5783 FINANCIAL CYCLES

Shemos 25:2
דַבֵּר אֶל־בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל וְיִקְחוּ־לָי תְּרוּמֶה מֵאֶת כּל־אִישׁ אֲשֶׁר יִדְּבֶנוּ לִבּוֹ תִּקְחָוּ אֶת־תְּרוּמָתִי:
Tell the Israelite people to bring Me gifts; you shall accept gifts for Me from every person whose heart is so moved.
What does this mean?
Rashi THAT THEY TAKE ME A HEAVE OFFERING — "Me" means to the glory of My Name.
Shev Shmaysa Why is the construction of the Mishkan singled out as requiring <i>lishmah</i> , doing it for its own sake?
He answers based on the Alshich in Kiddushin 7: when a woman gives a gift to a person of status, it is considered like she receives something.
So too, in this case when we bring gifts to Hashem.
Degel Machane Ephraim Eruvin 54 teaches us that this world is compared to a wedding.
We are here to get married to Hashem and we are focused on the externalities.
Meor V'Shemesh Hashem asks the people to do for His sake. He wants them to be satisfied with their lot.
Then He will know that the people are in it for the right reasons.

Shemos 25:10–11
ּוְעָשָׂוּ אָרָוֹן עֲצֵי שִׁמָּתַּיִם אַמָּתַּיִם וָחַצִּי ארְכָּוֹ וְאַמֶּה וָחֵצִי רֹחָבֹּוֹ וְאַמֶּה וָחֵצִי קֹמָתְוֹ: וְצִפִּיתָ אֹתוֹ זָהֶב טָהוֹר מִבַּיִת וּמְחָוּץ תְּצַפֶּנוּ וְעָשִּׂיתָ עָלֶיו זֵר זָהָב סָבְיב:
They shall make an ark of acacia wood, two and a half cubits long, a cubit and a half wide, and a cubit and a half high. Overlay it with pure gold—overlay it inside and out—and make upon it a gold molding round about.
What can we learn from this?
Sefer Chasidim (in Otzar Peleos HaTorah) We display our beautiful items. We should do the same for our holy items, like sefarim.

Shemos 25:19-20

Make one cherub at one end and the other cherub at the other end; of one piece with the cover shall you make the cherubim at its two ends. The cherubim shall have their wings spread out above, shielding the cover with their wings. They shall confront each other, the faces of the cherubim being turned toward the cover.

There I will meet with you, and I will impart to you—from above the cover, from between the two cherubim that are on top of the Ark of the Pact—all that I will command you concerning the Israelite people.
Why does it use this unusual language?

Shemos 25:26
ָוְעָשִׂיתָ לֹּוֹ אַרְבַּע טַבְּעָת זָהֶב וְנָתַהָּ אֶת־הַטַבָּעֹת עַל אַרְבַּע הַפֵּאֹת אֲשֶׁר לְאַרְבַּע רַגְלָיו:
Make four gold rings for it, and attach the rings to the four corners at its four legs.
Why were these rings?
Kli Yakar Life is a ring. Someone who was on top can one day can be on the bottom the next.
Noda Beyehuda (Otzar Peleos HaTorah) Money is round as it moves and is not permanent.
